

## Ritual Design Template

What is your **intention** for the ritual?

*Example:*

*My intention for this ritual is that I want to transition from the research paper to our next unit effectively while also celebrating the accomplishments students have made and processing their struggles throughout the process.*

What **process** would best facilitate this intention?

*Example:*

*I think, in order to do this, I want to create two "boards" with large paper- one for students to write what they are proud of from the process and one to write what they are glad to be finished with from the project. They can all write on them, we can read them aloud, and then afterward, we will collectively determine how to destroy the poster that has "what we are done with." I will save the other one for the next day and use it to show how those accomplishments will help with the next unit.*

What **props** can be used for this ritual?

*Example:*

- The song "We are the Champions" can be playing as students come into the room, signifying the end of the research paper process.  
- Giant paper and markers will be needed for the two posters
